

PAST TENSE –ED ENDINGS**VARIAZIONI FONETICHE DELLA DESINENZA –ED
DEL PAST TENSE**

Il suffisso -ed si pronuncia in tre modi diversi: /t/, /d/ e /id/.

1. Con i verbi terminanti in **p, k, s, ch, sh, th**, e con il suono **f**, il suffisso -ed si pronuncia /t/.

touched asked stopped helped worked watched laughed washed danced

2. Con i verbi terminanti in **-d** e **-t** il suffisso -ed si pronuncia /id/.

wanted waited started hated needed skated

3. Con i verbi terminanti con tutti gli altri suoni il suffisso –ed si pronuncia /d/.

lived phoned cycled used loved answered listened moved

Ex: Leggi i seguenti verbi a voce alta e disponili nelle tre colonne a seconda della pronuncia della desinenza ed del past tense:

needed washed phoned started returned walked offered liked

listened finished repeated hated worked crashed added waited

played opened visited asked agreed closed travelled wanted acted

danced arrived invited stopped
