He was tired	Was he tired?	

WH- QUESTIONS: si formano con l'ausiliare did davanti al soggetto (o nel caso del verbo essere, spostandolo davanti al soggetto), aggiungendo all'inizio l'aggettivo o il pronome interrogativo Wh-
