- 2. I last met her on 4th July.
- 3. Chris was born on Christmas Day (25th December, on Easter day, on your birthday, on their wedding anniversary)
- 4. They arrived on the afternoon of the 10th.(on Friday morning)

# • IN <u>periodo di tempo lungo (mesi, anni, stagioni, secoli)- le parti del giorno, fra (periodo di tempo futuro), the morning-afternoon-evening</u>

- 1. I was born in August.
- 2. I was born in 1959.
- 3. I go to the beach in the summer.
- 4. Computers were invented in the 20th century.
- 5. I go to school in the morning. (in the afternoon, in the evening)
- 6. I'll be back in a week. (fra una settimana)
- 7. We meet each other every day in the morning/afternoon/evening.

# • BY -BEFORE <u>a/prima/non più tardi di quell' ora - data - periodo</u>

- 1. You should be back home by-before 11.00 p. m..
- 2. This project must be finished by-before the end of August.

# • ON TIME puntuale, né prima né dopo

- 1. The 8.20 train left on time today. (It started at 8.20)
  - IN TIME <u>in tempo, non dopo</u>
- 1. If you don't want to miss the train you must get there in time.
  - FROM ...... TO/TILL/UNTIL da ....a / fino
- 1. I work from 8.00 to / till / until 2.00 in the afternoon.

  - SINCE da un dato momento
