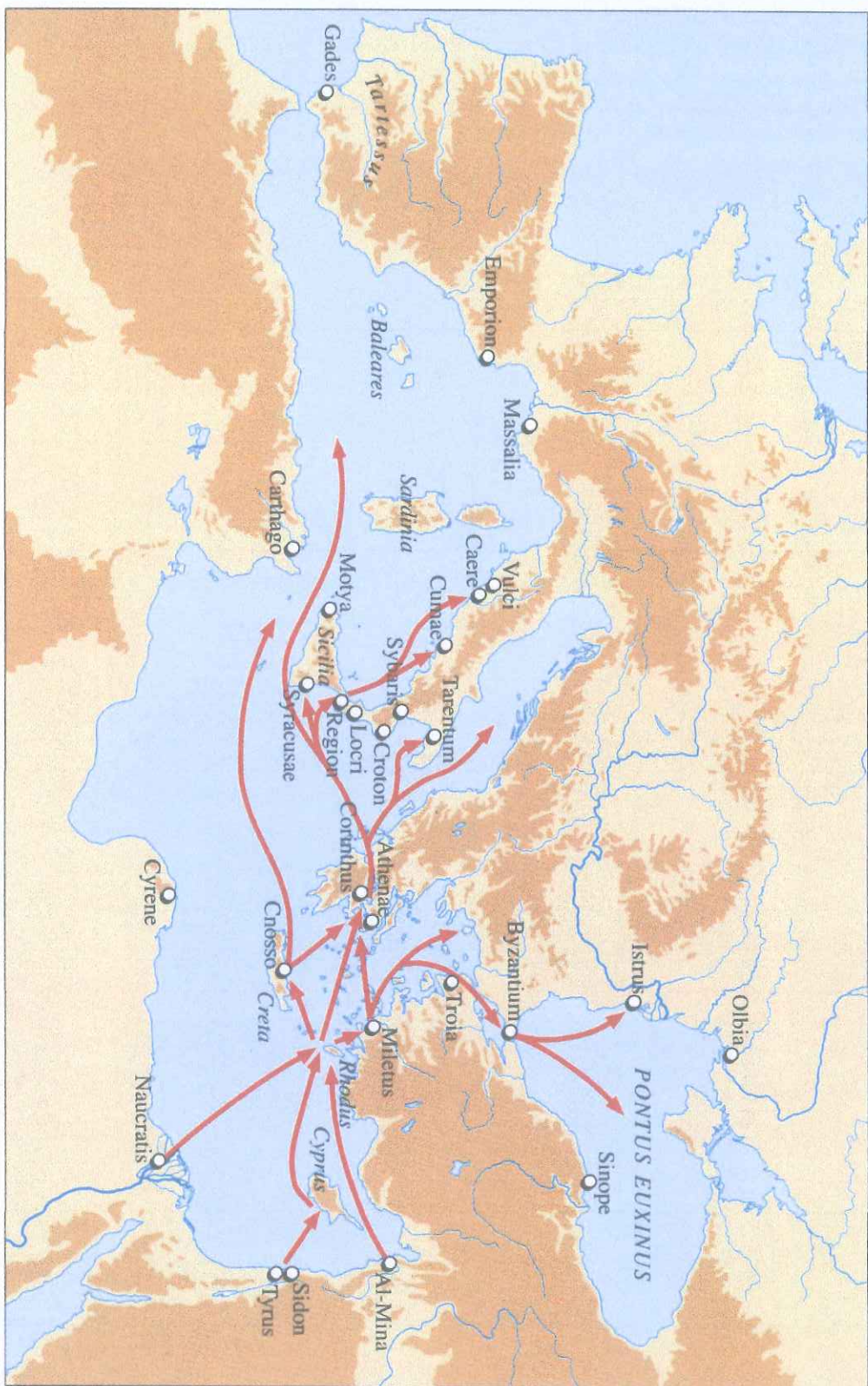


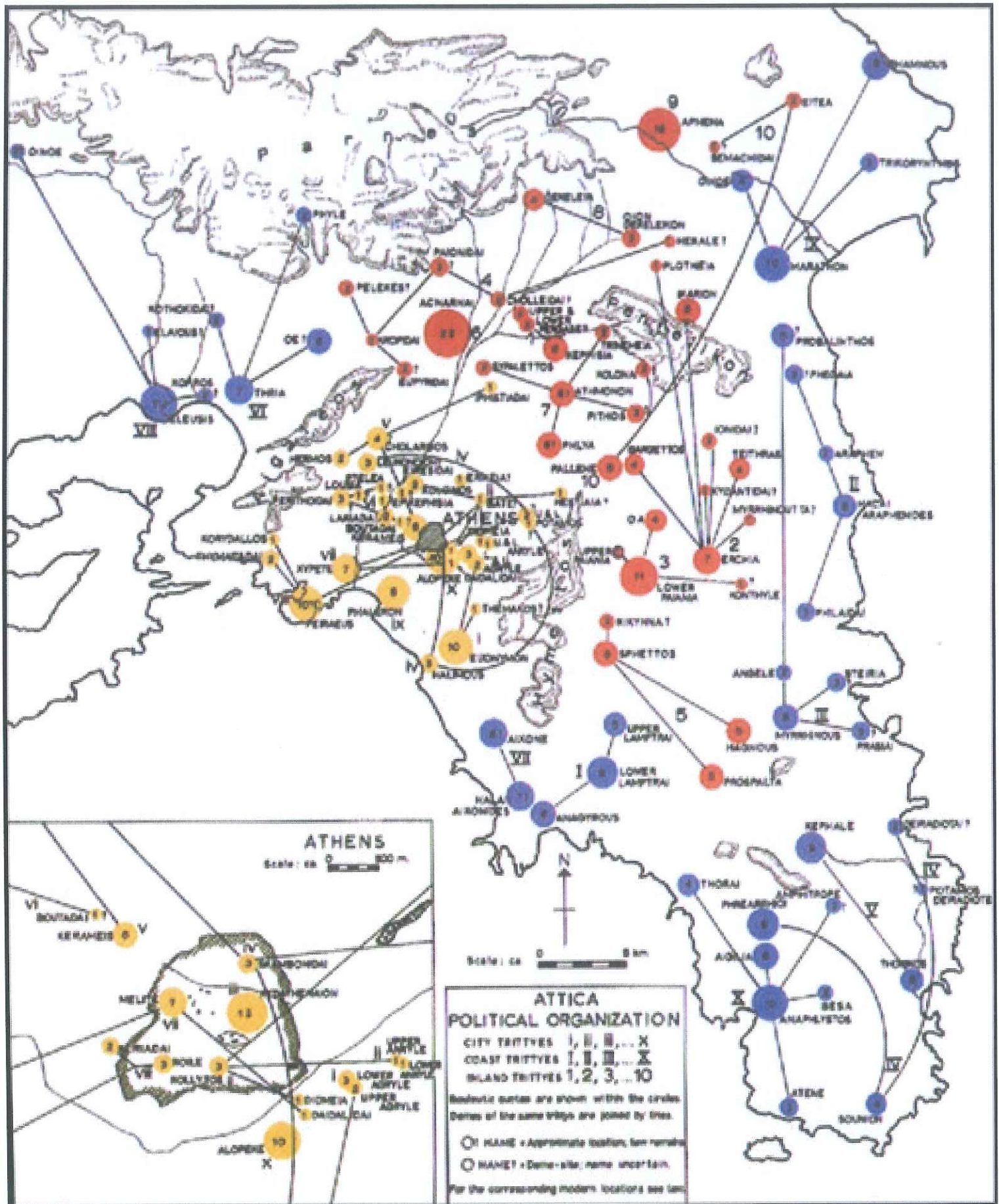


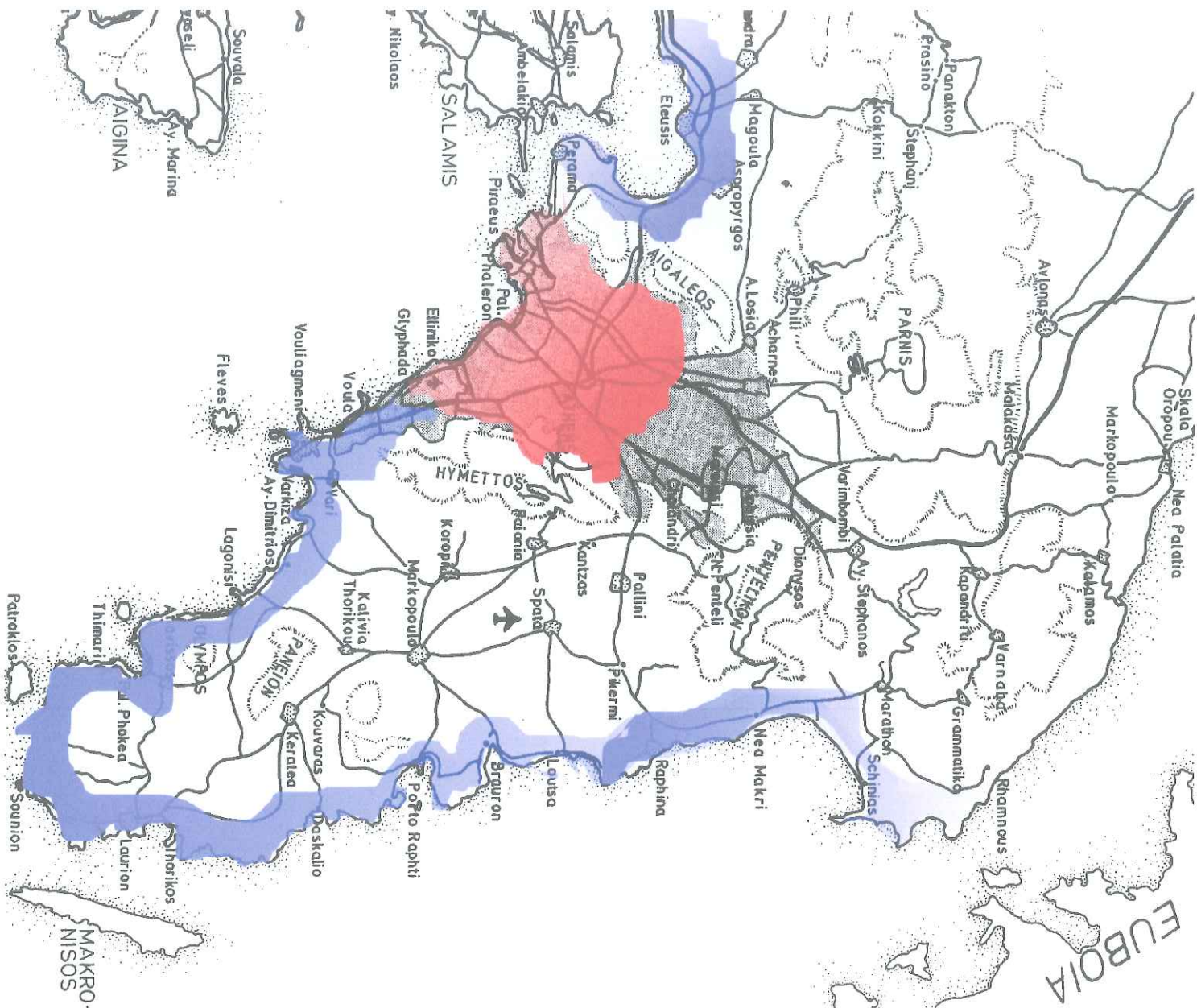
La colonizzazione greca 750/450 a.C.



Cartina dei principali itinerari marittimi al tempo della colonizzazione





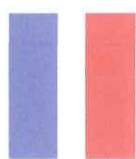
