

In particulary from this research, about the ease of starting a eHealth business, emerged that Denmark ranked extremely high in this category because, as the smaller countries - Ireland was top in this category - tend to support new businesses better than larger countries. The weakness of this country is that Denmark have one of the highest taxation in the world, but on the other hand Danish goverment provide efficiently a lot of public services for citizens and companies. Furthermore the goals of the Danish government's strategy about eHealth and the Danish people's digital skills will be a driver for the growth of this sector. In conclusion, with the right investment and the right place, Google and Den-
