+	We were at home yesterday.	
?	Were we at home yesterday ?	Yes, we were. / No, we weren't.
-	We were not (weren't) at home yesterday.	
+	He was my friend.	
?	Was he my friend?	Yes, he was. / No, he wasn't.
-	He was not my friend.	

To have		Short answers
+	You had an old car.	
?	Had you an old car?	Yes, I had. / No, I hadn't.
?	Did you have an old car?	Yes, I did. / No, I didn't.
-	You had not (hadn't) a new car.	
-	You didn't have a new car.	
+	He had a French friend.	
?	Had he a French friend?	Yes, he had. / No, he hadn't.
?	Did he have a French friend?	Yes, he did. / No, he didn't.
-	He had not (hadn't) a French friend.	
-	He didn't have a French friend.	

To study		Short answers
+	You studied last night.	
?	Did you study last night?	Yes, I did. / No, I didn't.
-	You didn't study last night.	
+	He studied yesterday.	
?	Did he study yesterday?	Yes, he did. / No, he didn't.
-	He did not (didn't) study yesterday.	

To go		Short answers
+	We went to school yesterday.	
?	Did we go to school?	Yes, we did. / No, we didn't.
-	We didn't go to school.	
+	He went to school yesterday.	
?	Did he go to school?	Yes, he did. / No, he didn't.
-	He did not (didn't) go to school yesterday.
