adverbs

○ Adverbs express manner (how):
quickly, slowly

- Adjectives qualify nouns: brown hair

- Adverbs qualify verbs: **go slowly**

e.g., you speak English very well

adverbs

- ✘ form adverbs by adding **-ly** to the adjective: e.g., **sad-ly**, **bad-ly**
- ✘ Some adjectives go through a morphological change:
e.g., **happy** – **happily**
- ✘ Irregular adverbs:
 - ✘ Fast **→** **fast**,
 - ✘ Good **→** **well**,
 - ✘ Hard **→** **hard**.

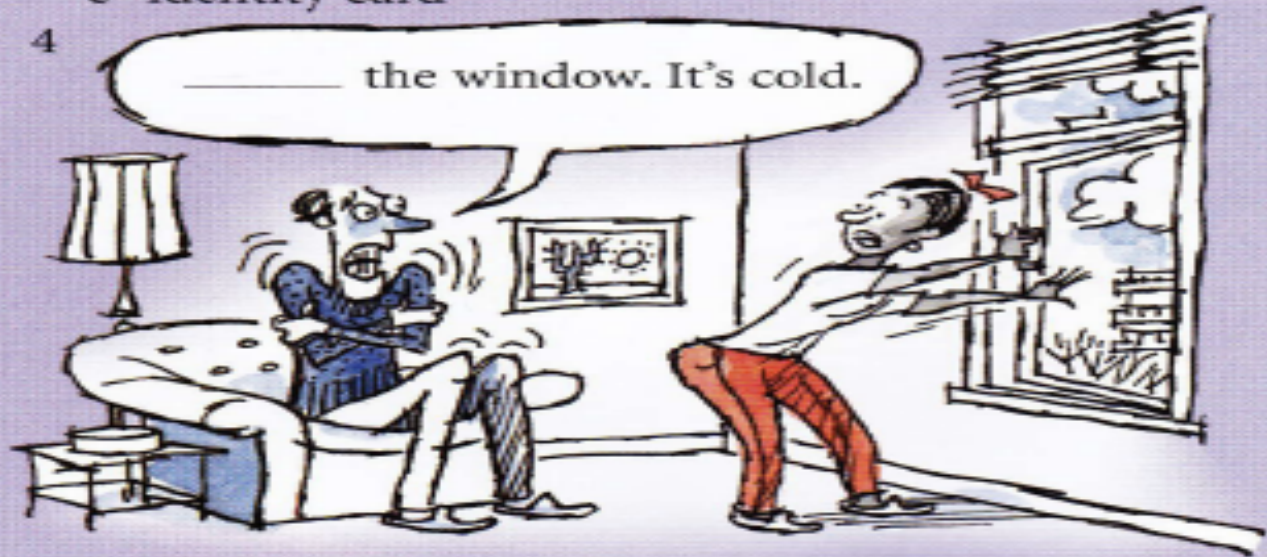

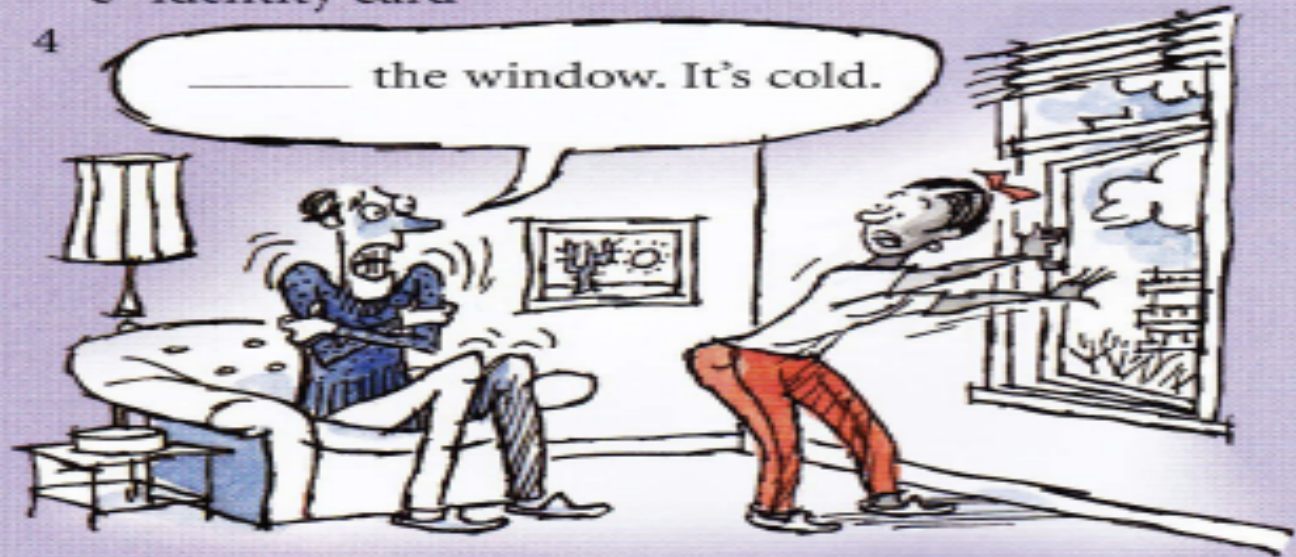

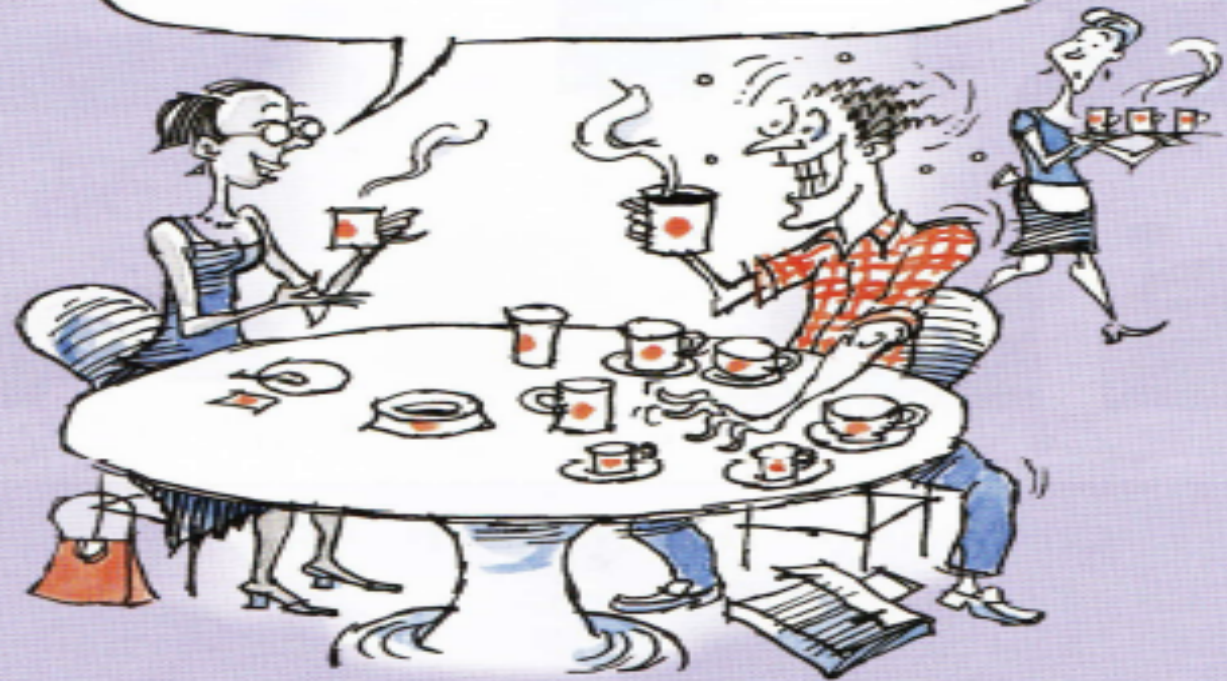
