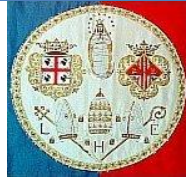

<b>Obiettivi formativi</b>	In short term, the objective of the course is threefold: To introduce the opportunities given by the funding programs of the European Union To stimulate the acquisition of skills in the field of European Project Planning students and teachers (also from EDUC alliance University) staff of third sector entities. In long term: To encourage students to set up design and to implement their own European projects and realise the digital or physical mobility in cooperation with the students from the partners university



	<p>To encourage cooperation between teachers and between students from partners universities, intercultural exchanges, and digital cooperation</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><i>Contenuti</i></p>	<p>The course IEPP is organized into 5 didactic modules; each of these introduces the participants to European Project Planning. The approach used in the IEPP course is both theoretical and practical, based on the expertise of the course teachers (Teachers from EDUC alliance Universities and professionals already employed in the university master in European Project Planning). A practical simulation is carried out in the module n°4 and n°5. The practical simulation, in working group, is based on the use of the documentation made available by the EU funding program. In particular:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Module1: European Union’s policies and European Funding Programmes</b> Brief Analysis of the European Union's policies and new funding opportunities.</li> <li>• <b>Module 2: Techniques and tools for the project idea definition</b> Overview of the strategies, tools and techniques for the project idea definition (i.e. Logical Framework)</li> <li>• <b>Module 3: How to fill the application form</b> Practical information to fill the application form (templates, program manuals, Application procedures, eligibility criteria and assessment criteria)</li> <li>• <b>Module 4: Budgeting</b> Administrative and financial rules for the project budget creation</li> <li>• <b>Module 5: Design, implementation and evaluation of international projects set up by the students (12 hours, February-March).</b> This module is based on the project-based learning and it proposes to the student the design, implementation, and evaluation of international projects (social, educational, or humanitarian project). Students remain authors and initiators of the projects and through experimentation in the implementation of this project, they learn how to use this project-based pedagogy in their future professional life. The partnership between universities will allow a cooperation between students from universities on the thematic projects and implement them in the countries of the partner university.</li> </ul> <p>The total duration of the e-learning course program is 24 hours, through an online learning platform Moodle Educ with the digital cooperation platform (i.e Klaxoon, Microsoft teams). The course will be organized during the academic year, starting with the winter semester. Students who demonstrate the necessary language skills will be able to participate in the module 5.</p>
