Prof. Angelica Dessì, M.D.

Angelica Dessì is an Associate Professor of pediatrics at University of Cagliari. She obtained her postgraduate in Paediatrics (2011) and her Medical Degree (2006) with highest honours, both at the University of Cagliari under the supervision of Prof. Vassilios Fanos. Her postgraduate thesis dealt about intrauterine growth retardation and metabolomics. Then she continued to work and take care of metabolomics studies, particularly on the fetal-neonatal nutrition and prevention of chronic diseases in adults such as obesity, diabetes and metabolic syndrome. She has written over 200 publications (of which 76 on Pub Med) in National and International Journals. She also participated as a speaker at over 50 National and International meetings. She's a board member in International Journals (Global Journal of Obesity, Diabetes and Metabolic Syndrome, Global Research Journal of Public Health and Epidemiology, Imaging Journal of Clinical and Medical Sciences and Pediatrics and Neonatal Care) and a consultant referee of International Journals (Pediatric Research, BioMed Central Pediatrics, Journal of Pediatric and Neonatal Individualized Medicine, The Italian Journal of Pediatrics, Expert Opinion on Pharmacotherapy, International Journal of Developmental Neuroscience and Case Reports in Pediatrics). Since 2018 she has been working as Professor in Pediatrics at the Department of Neonatal Intensive Care Unit at University of Cagliari.
