## Objectives

The course offers a multidisciplinary training, which prepares for professions in private organizations and public administrations. In particular, it aims to form a figure with transversal skills, able to fit into organizational processes, to reason by projects and objectives and equipped with the necessary skills to work in contexts where internal control activities are functional to the improvement of the quality of processes and organizational efficiency and effectiveness.

The course of study is highly specialising thanks to laboratories and training.

## Careers

Graduates will have transversal skills in the organizational-managerial area. In particular, they can perform management support activities in the area of control, quality and evaluation, having acquired, among others, skills such as:

- the ability of socio-psychological and technical-juridical analysis of organizational processes;
- the ability to collaborate in team activities aimed at collecting data and preparing preliminary reports to implement policies and manage services;



- the ability to manage and control public and private bureaucracies;
- the ability to measure costs and benefits of public investments;
- the ability to negotiate and mediate internal and external conflicts;

Graduates can enrol in first level Master's and Master's Degree courses consistent with the three-year course.

## Organization and method

The teaching activity takes place in two ways: traditional or mixed. It is divided into theoretical lessons, supplemented by tutors; internships at public administrations or private organizations and thematic deepening laboratories, managed by public officials and business operators.

## Duration and programme

The course counts 18 exams, including one in English, 18 free credits to be acquired through exams chosen by the students, 12 free credits to be acquired through educational activities or other exams, selected by the students, 6 credits to be acquired through an internship at public administrations or private organizations.

## International experiences

The course, through the Erasmus+ and Globus programs, guarantees students the possibility of studying or doing an internship in a European or non-European country, in order to acquire useful skills to work abroad.

## Internship

The course includes an internship in public administrations or private institutions to integrate training with practical skills.

## Course in blended mode (online and traditional)

The course is also provided in mixed mode, for students who work or live outside Cagliari, or for students who cannot attend classes regularly for other reasons. For those who choose this mode, the lessons - recorded by the professors - are available on the dedicated portal.

## Admission requirements

Access to the course requires a high school diploma or an equivalent foreign degree. Before enrolment, students must take a non-selective test, aimed at verifying their own skills with respect to the contents of the course.
