Objectives and careers

The educational programme provides access to a wide range of mid-level professions and careers depending on the selected curriculum. Graduates will have access to white-collar and journalistic career. For those who choose the political-international curriculum, there will be the chance to work for organizations and companies with an international vocation, foreign relations services and press offices, governmental organizations and NGOs; while students who opt for the social curriculum could work for organizations in the areas of programming and organization of services, public relations and communication, selection and management of human resources, territorial planning and tourism.

Organization and method

The educational activities of the Degree Course are organized based on an annual calendar available at the beginning of the academic year. Lectures, exercises and seminar activities are planned in addition to individual study. Attendance is not mandatory, although it is strongly recommended. Furthermore, an incoming, on-going and outgoing study guidance is available, whose task is on the one hand, to facilitate the knowledge of international and non-international opportunities for students; on the other, to

make the course of study more profitable and punctual. Students are supported in their learning by a tutoring service. The Degree Course offers the opportunity to access the Erasmus+ and Globus programmes, as well as internship experiences. All this allows to study, work and live significant experiences in European and non-European countries. The exams are conducted in oral or written mode, and there are midterm exams.

Admission requirements

Admission to the Degree Course in Political Science requires a secondary school diploma (five-year) or a recognized foreign qualification. At the beginning of the academic year, students' incoming knowledge is assessed through mandatory but non-selective tests, aimed at assessing their incoming level of competence on the following areas:

- general culture
- text comprehension
- logic and maths
- English language

On the course web page a syllabus of the competence assessment test is available.

Failure to pass the test does not, in any case, affect enrolment. The course guarantees realignment activities for students with incoming gaps.

Duration and programme

The Degree in Political Science has a three-year duration. The course counts 20 compulsory exams, including an English language exam and a second language to be

chosen among French, German, Spanish, Arabic and Chinese; 15 free credits that the student can acquire through exams, seminars or internships. In the third year, students can opt for a political-international curriculum or a social curriculum. The course promotes international mobility programmes and qualified internship experiences in addition to academic training.

Access to Master's Degrees

The Degree in Political Science allows direct access to Master's Degree Courses in International Relations (LM-52), Society and Territory Policies (LM-62) and Public Administration Sciences (LM-63). It also allows access to other Master's Degree courses with the integration of exams where required.
