Abstract

The English for Academic Activities course is a five day intensive course designed for teachers, lecturers, and academics who use English in their professional environments. This course supports participants in refining their academic oral, writing and communication skills, enhancing their ability to teach and engage in scholarly activities in an international setting.

Participants will develop their proficiency in English as a medium of instruction, gain practical insights into academic writing and oral communication, and explore strategies for effective assessment and materials development. The course also provides opportunities for reflection on academic practices and intercultural communication, ensuring that academics can confidently navigate diverse educational contexts.
