**Duration and activities:** The single-cycle degree course in Medicine and Surgery has a duration of six years. The unit of measurement of the work required from the student for the completion of each educational activity in order to obtain the degree is the University Educational Credit(CFU). The course of study envisages the acquisition of a total of 360 CFU, at least 60of which are to be acquired in educational activities aimed at maturing specific professional skills..

**Objectives and job opportunities:** The mission of the Degree Course is identified with the training of a doctor at an initial professional level, with a biomedical-psycho-social culture, who possesses a multidisciplinary and integrated vision of the most common problems of health and illness,with an education oriented to the community, to the territory and basically to the prevention of illness, to the promotion of health and with a humanistic culture in its medical aspects.

**Organisation and method:** The course of study is organised in integrated courses divided into semesters.Attendance is compulsory for both lecture hours and professional training hours. Incoming students are subject to an English language placement test as envisaged by the UNICA-CLA English Language Project. The training activity envisages lectures, participation in seminars, practical exercises on the techniques described in the lessons, and clinical internships in healthcare facilities, including those outside the University.
