## Presentation

---

The Double Master Degree agreement between the **University of Cagliari** and the **University of Potsdam** allows **4 students** enrolled on the Master courses in Modern European and American Languages and Literatures and Specialized Translation and Interpreting to obtain a **double Master degree in Italy and Germany**.

The exchange course will take place during the **first semester of the second year** of the Master's degree course, during which the students will attend the courses envisaged by the double degree syllabus and take exams at the Universität Potsdam. They will then discuss their thesis at the University of Cagliari or, by agreement, jointly at the two universities.

## Training Course

---

Students interested in the exchange programme will apply for the Erasmus+ call for applications during the **first academic year** (4 mobility grants will be dedicated to the Double Degree each year). They will then leave for Potsdam in September, at the beginning of their **second academic year**.

## Entry Requirements

---

The requirements for admission to the selection are:

- > an adequate knowledge of the German language, corresponding to level C1;
- > having passed all first year examinations year prior to departure (as stated in the text of the international agreement)

An examining board will check that the necessary requirements are met and will create a ranking by awarding each candidate a score on the basis of **academic merit** and an **interview** during which the candidate's motivation will be assessed.

The selection will then be validated upon enrolment in the second year

## Training Goals

---

- > to gain international study experience;
- > to get acquainted with the German university system;
- > to benefit from the complementary teaching offered by two European universities;
- > to increase job opportunities by obtaining two degrees.
