A Territorial Evaluation Framework for Post-2027 EU Policies

Abstract. Enhancing Europe's competitiveness and cohesion is a top priority for the EU. The JRC, through the Territorial Data Analysis and Modelling (TEDAM) team, plays a key role in this mission by evaluating the impact and effectiveness of EU funding programs across countries and regions. By using diverse quantitative economic methods for impact assessments, monitoring, and evaluation, this research promotes transparency and accountability, bolstering public trust in European policies. It also provides policymakers with the evidence needed to foster social and territorial inclusion and promote sustainable development. TEDAM focuses on the European territorial dimension (down to the NUTS 2 regional level), with work organized along two pillars: (i) Modelling for policy impact assessment using the dynamic spatial computable general equilibrium (CGE) model, RHOMOLO. (ii) Mapping and analysis of regional data, focusing on key statistical indicators and micro-level data through the Regional Economic Monitoring (REMO) activity. This seminar will present recent evidence from JRC research and policy development relevant to economists and analysts working on policy monitoring and evaluation.
